ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PROHIBITING LOITERING AND ESTABLISHING PENALITIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Brownton ordains:

Section 1. The act of loitering shall be defined as conduct by any person consisting of lounging, sleeping, lurking, lying about, sitting, standing, idly remaining, or any other state or condition without legal, real or apparent purpose other than to stand idly about, to linger aimlessly or to loaf.

Section 2. Loitering, as defined in Section 1 herein, on any public street, sidewalk, alley, thoroughfare or other public way is hereby declared a nuisance and is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by fine of not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment not to exceed 90 days, or both.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect following its passage and publication.
