ORDINANCE NO. 44

ORDINANCE REGARDING THE PLATTING OF REAL PROPERTY IN BROWNTON

The Council of the City of Brownton ordains:

- Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to set certain guidelines and to control the development of areas which may become, at a future date, annexed and platted.
- Section 2. That before any Petition for Annexation will be considered by the City Council, the petitioning landowner must provide the council with a brief outline of the plan of development, including a proposal for platting the said premises. In accordance with this requirement that owner shall furnish the City Council with a map or drawing showing the location of the property sought to be annexed and platted. Such drawing shall show location of all blocks and lots, placement of streets and/or alleys showing locations of easement areas for water, sewer, electric and telephone utilities.
- Section 3. The council may waive the requirements of this ordinance by unanimous vote in the case of small or isolated parcels of property.
- Section 4. This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
