CITY SERVICES

The City provides the following services for its residents: electric, natural gas, water, sewer, and garbage/recycling. Bills are sent out on the 10th of the month and payable by the 25th day of the month, after which they are subject to a 10% penalty. Utility bills are considered delinquent on the 26th of the month.

GARBAGE SERVICES

Garbage is collected by West Central Sanitation weekly on Tuesdays. Base monthly garage rate are as follows: 35 gallon cart - \$11.97, 65 gallon cart - \$12.80, 95 gallon cart - \$14.83.

RECYCLING

Curbside recycling is collected every other Tuesday on garbage days.

YARD WASTE SITE

Grass clippings, leaves and branches can be taken to the Yard Waste Site on 1st Avenue South. Appliances and e-waste can also be disposed of at the Yard Waste Site. Permits and fees for disposal are taken care of at the City Clerk's Office. The site will be opened and monitored according to the following schedule:

Tuesday and Thursday 4 - 8 p.m.

Saturday 9 a.m. - 5p.m.

May through October

Site will be closed in adverse weather.

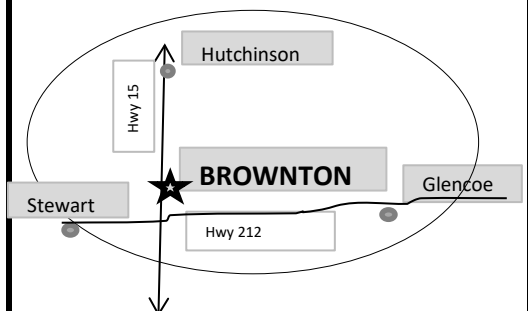

FIXING UP YOUR HOME?

All construction in the City of Brownton is subject to the requirements of the State Building Code.

The City requires building permits to make sure that construction meets minimum standards.

A permit is needed for new construction, remodeling including reroofing etc. If you are planning some construction, be sure to contact the City Clerk's Office prior to construction to see if you need a permit!

DOG AND CAT OWNERS

All dogs and cats in the City of Brownton are required to be licensed each year. Cost of license is \$25.00; or \$5.00 if the pet is spayed or neutered. Upon application for license, proof of current vaccination for rabies will be required. Citations will be issued for all unlicensed dogs and cats with a fine assessed according to the ordinance. Limit of four (4) pets per household. No dog or cats shall be allowed to run at large within the City at anytime. License(s) must be renewed each year by the first of January each year.

GOPHER STATE ONE CALL

Anyone digging in the State of Minnesota must call Gopher State One Call before they dig if they are using power equipment. Even when hand-digging, a person is encouraged to call if he/she is unfamiliar with the location of underground utilities. The Person who is doing the work is responsible for calling GSOC. If a contractor is hired, they are responsible for calling.

GRASS CLIPPINGS

Please do not discharge lawn clippings from your lawn mower onto the City street when mowing the boulevard. City Ordinance prohibits this and established a fine for repeated violations. The lawn clippings will wash in to the storm sewer, causing them to clog up. It takes considerable time and expense to clean them out
